CHARGING POLICY

St John's Primary School will ask parents for voluntary contributions for:

- School trips/in-school special events
- School residentials
- Mufti days
- Charity events
- Parties

The school reserves the right to cancel activities / events / trips if voluntary contributions do not cover the cost.

The school will not charge for property damaged accidentally but where it is considers that property / equipment has been damaged maliciously a charge will be made.

The school will ask for a contribution for lost reading books and bags.

Milk

Under fives – daily milk is free Over fives – the current rate for a 1/3 of a pint of milk is charged for any parent wanting milk for their child.

Fruit

No charge as fruit is free for all Reception and Key Stage 1 children

Breakfast Club

£3 per session (7.45 - 8.50)

After School Club

St John's has an After School Club. The charge is £3 for the first hour (whether it is for the full hour or part there of), £5 for any additional time paid on a pro-rata basis.

The club runs from 3.10pm to 5.30pm.

Dinner Money

Full week £8.50 1 day £1.70

Dinner Money should be paid every Monday. It should be placed in an envelope with the

child's name and amount enclosed stated clearly on it. This should then be handed to the class teacher.

The school reserves the right to refer outstanding debts to the Local Authority Debt Collection Service.
