#### Meet the Teacher

## <u>Clubs</u>

Our extra-curricular clubs for Years 1-6 will start during the week commencing  $19^{th}$  September. Mr Willmott is now in charge of our clubs timetable and will publicise the timetable in due course. Individual teachers will send home letters for their clubs; we ask for reply slips to be returned as soon as you are able. Confirmation will be sent out on Friday  $16^{th}$ . Reception will have clubs available later in the year once they are fully settled into school life.

FAST club and breakfast club have re-started and they have sent booking forms to families who have used the service in the past. Should you not have received a form, or wish to make a new one-off or regular booking, please contact Mrs Bond in the office.

#### <u>Nuts</u>

Please can I ask that parents refrain form sending anything containing nuts into school — either as a snack or in a packed lunch. We have a few members of our school community with severe nut allergies and thus we strive to ensure we are nut-free. I am afraid this means we have to ask for no Nutella or peanut butter in sandwiches unless nut-free alternatives.

Children in Reception receive a snack each day in school as part of their curriculum. Children in Years 1 and 2 receive fruit each day. Children in Years 3 – 6 may bring in fruit for break time. Thank you for your cooperation in these matters.
