NSPCC: Speak out stay safe

I am pleased to inform you that we are participating in the **NSPCC's Speak** out. Stay safe. Programme this term. Speak out. Stay safe. is a programme for children aged 5-11 which aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or Childline. The assemblies will take place in two halves with Y2-6 having had their assembly already and Reception and Year 1 assembly will be on Monday 24th June. As part of
