Easter Bingo

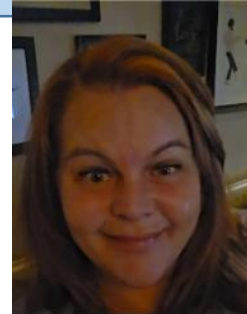
